Grants for International Strategic Collaboration 2014

Utrecht University Intensive Workshops

Utrecht University can co-fund joint scientific workshops in the academic year 2014 to strengthen the ties with its strategic international partners (UUPs) and other international partners with a strong international profile in at least one UU strategic theme by bringing top scholars together. The workshop should focus on the development of new joint research or education projects.

Utrecht University Visiting Fellowships

Utrecht University can co-fund visiting fellowships in academic year 2014 to strengthen the ties between Utrecht University and its strategic international partners (UUPs). The fellowship should focus on the development of new joint activities in education or research.

Utrecht University Short Stay PhD Fellowships

Utrecht University offers fellowship grants for PhD candidates from Utrecht University for a research visit to a Utrecht University Partner. The fellowship should explicitly contribute to the research project of the PhD candidate and strengthen ties between both research groups.

Utrecht University Marie Skłodowska Curie Support Grant Utrecht University supports its research groups to host a Marie Skłodowska Curie fellow from a Utrecht University Partner.

Utrecht University – Chinese University of Hong Kong short term Faculty and PhD Exchange

Utrecht University offers grants for short term exchange with the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
